## Caribou Patrols:

**Who:** 2 crews, each comprised of 2 AWN members

**What:** conduct patrols, collect information on wildlife and on effectiveness of existing barriers to vehicle traffic

**Where:** west-central Alberta, within 100 km radius of Grande Cache

**When:** November, 2013 through to March, 2014

**Why:** to assist in caribou recovery strategies and reduce the potential of caribou mortality by vehicle collisions



- Patrol persons are observers and do not have any regulatory enforcement authority, although they can collect information that could be passed on to the Regulator.
- Given the success of last year's pilot project, the Partners agreed to extend patrols for a second season.
- Crews are employed by the Aseniwuche Environmental Corporation (AEC) under contract to Aseniwuche Winewak Nation of Canada (AWN)
