


Figure 2 Change in education attainment, YH 94 1986-1996.

Figure 3 Change in education attainment, Hinton 1986-1996.





Figure 4 Change in education attainment, Jasper 1986-1996.

Figure 5 Change in education attainment, Grande Cache 1986-1996.







Figure 6 Level of education as a percent of total population 15+, 1996











-note- Because of the way Statistics Canada reports level of education, individuals who have attended some type of post-secondary institution but do not possess a degree are not counted as having a high school diploma. For the purpose of the above chart it was assumed that those enrolled in trades, other non-university diploma, or university programmes who do not possess degrees have at least acquired a high school diploma. The authors acknowledge that this potentially introduces a slight error if there are individuals enrolled in post-secondary education without a high school diploma.
