(*adjusted to 1996 dollars)

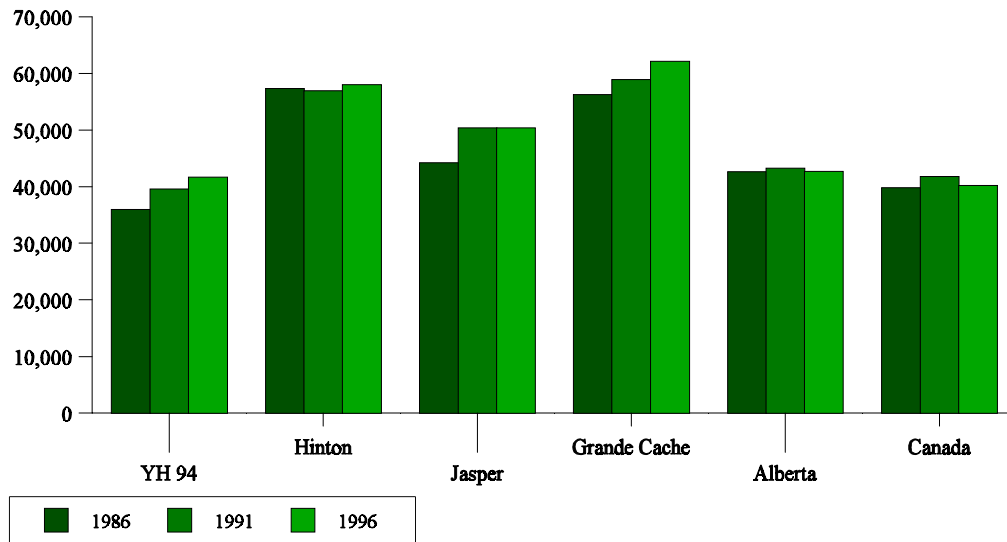
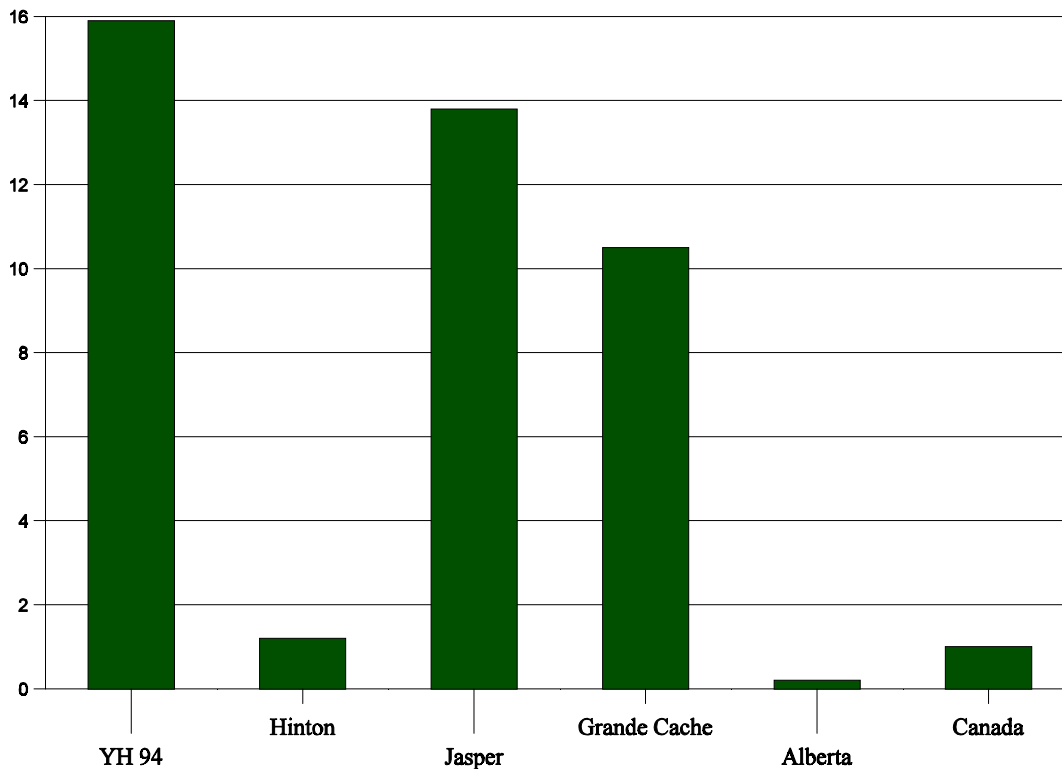

Income distribution for YH94

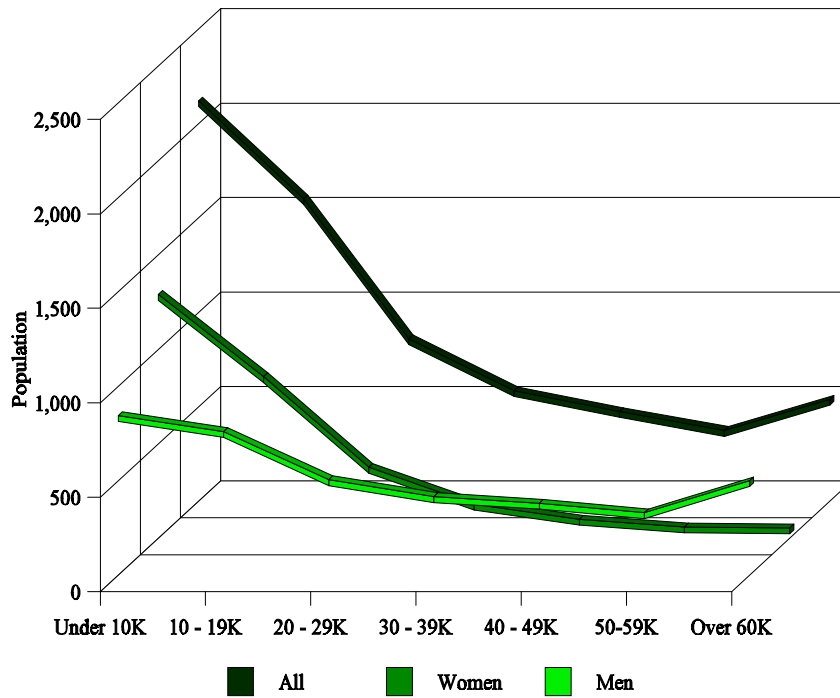
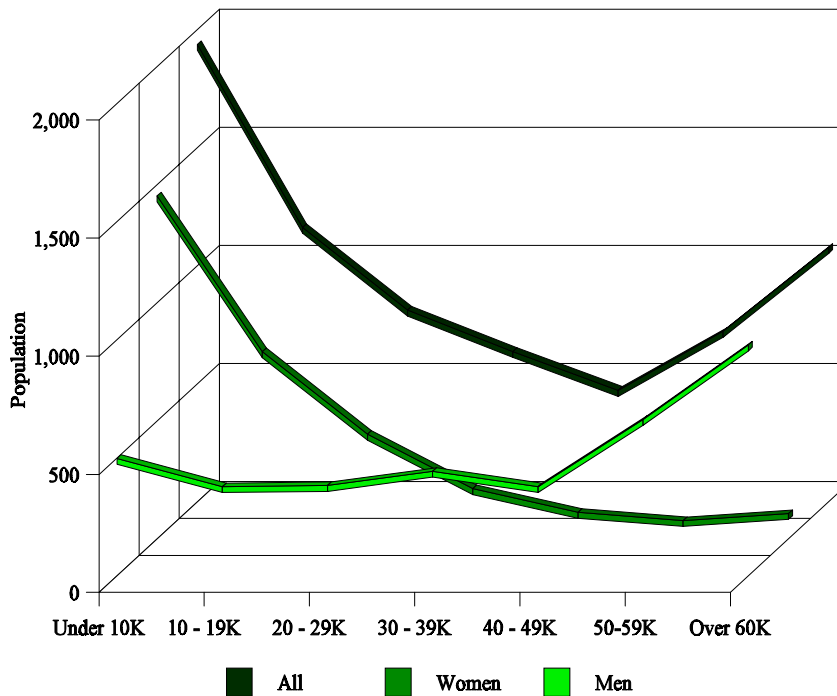

Income distribution for Jasper

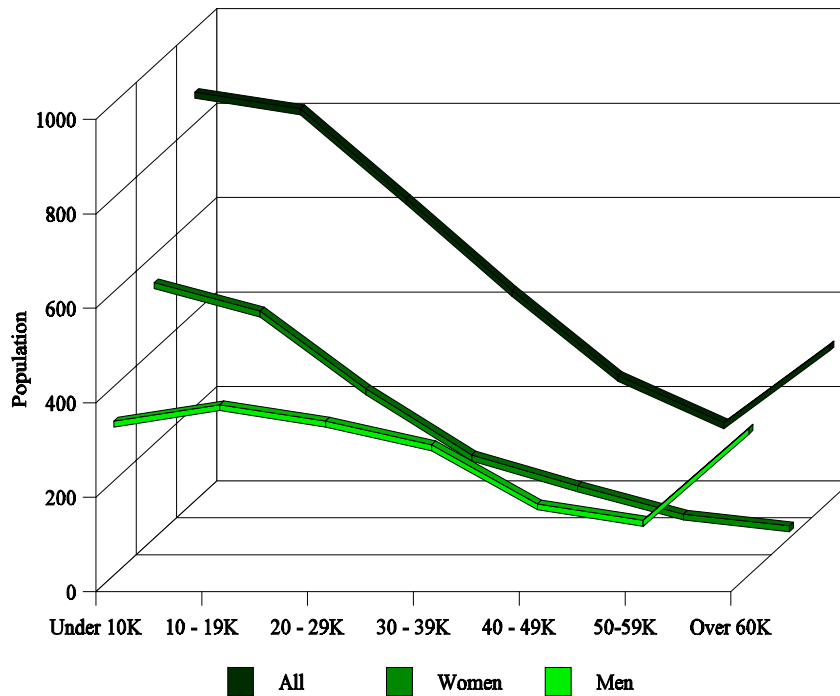
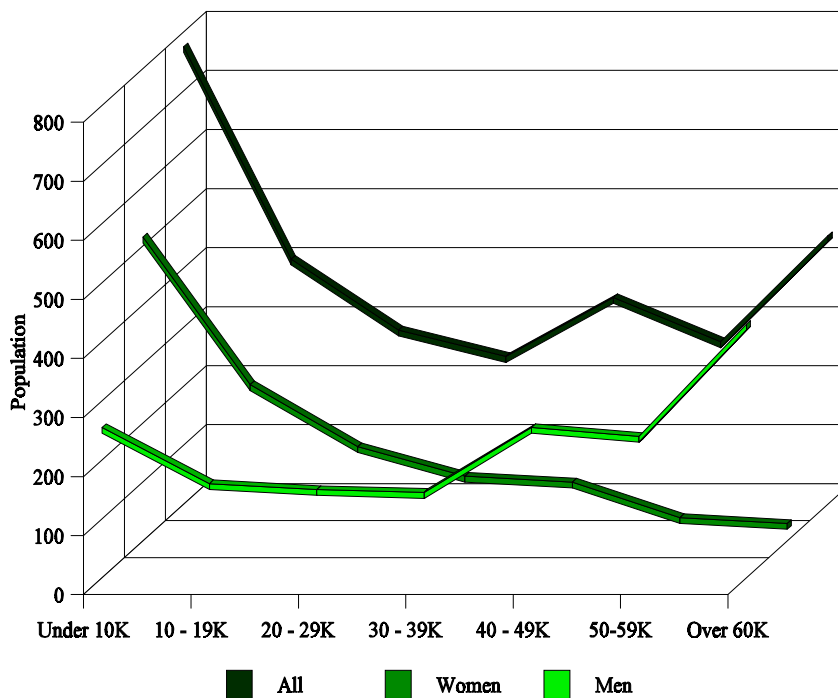

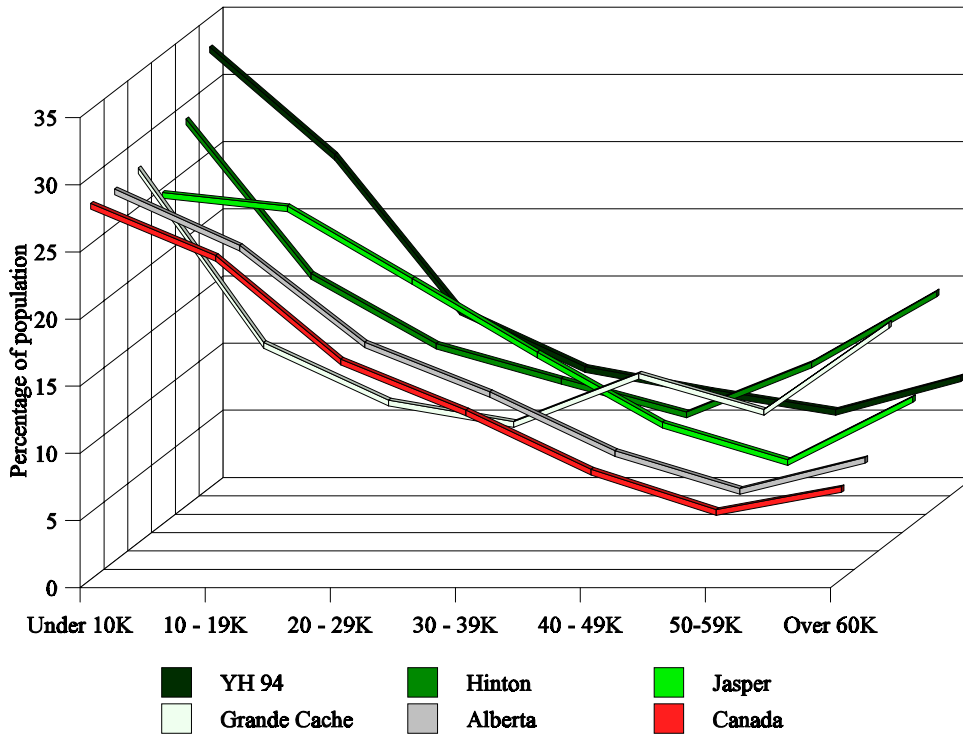
