



Poverty Figures







-note- Statistics Canada measures incidence of low income based on the percentage of income spent on basic necessities such as food, shelter, and clothing. It is assumed that persons spending greater than 20% above the national average for basic necessities is in 'straitened' circumstances. These numbers are adjusted periodically for the size of area of residence and family size.

Figure 2 Incidence of low income for unattached individuals, 1986-1996





Figure 3 Incidence of low income for economic families, 1986-1996
