

Percentage change in population 1986-1996




Figure 3 Percentage of total population by age cohort, 1996





Figure 4 Percentage of total population by age cohort, 1986





Income distribution for Jasper, 1996




Figure 9 Incidence of low income by family and individual, 1996













Average value of a dwelling, 1986-1996* (*adjusted to 1996 dollars)
















Level of education as a percent of total population 15+, 1996





Female labour force participation rates, 1986-1996





Figure 22 Female unemployment rates, 1986-1996

Male labour force participation rates, 1986-1996




