

Reversed decline of 1996-2001 period Increase of 1.6 to 3.4% across CSDs












Ageing population














Income Distribution 2/3



Percentage high incomes than. More higher incomes in FRI than Canada.













Key Points

- 411% increase in 65-74 age cohort over last
 20 years
- Hinton has had a notable decrease in lower incomes and an increase in higher incomes
- Less income disparity than Canada
- Éducation levels lower than Alberta and Canada but improving
