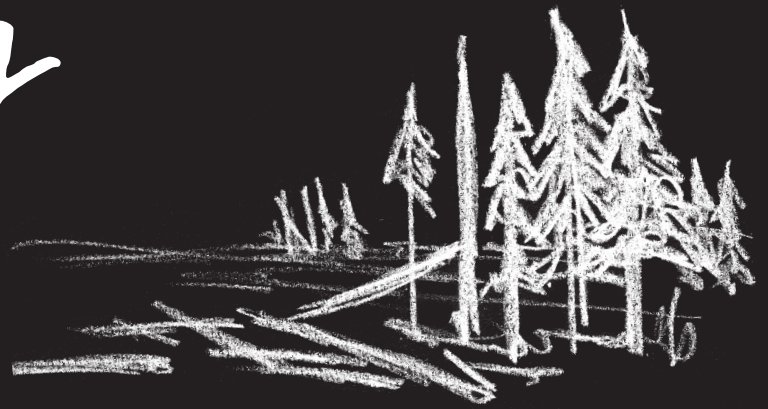




VALUE FOR Forestry

We deliver the tools and information you need to practice sustainable forest management. Our science directly helps the forest industry fulfill obligations such as the Canadian Boreal Forest Agreement, and by contributing to a healthier forest, our partners build social license for their operations.



GRIZZLY BEAR TOOLS

Plug in harvesting and road plans, and our model produces maps of how grizzly bear habitat is affected, including mortality risks.



GROWTH AND YIELD

The FGROW members pool their permanent sample plot data to create and calibrate better growth and yield models.



WILDFIRE PATTERNS

Our database of 129 historical wildfires reveals the Natural Range of Variation across the boreal. This provides scientifically defensible guidance for management plans.



FOOTHILLS STREAM CROSSING PARTNERSHIP

Our protocol for mitigating stream crossings is recognized by the Government of Alberta and is used by over 12 companies on 1300+ stream crossings.



CARIBOU CONSERVATION

We found which forestry treatments increase the abundance of caribou foods, and how different management strategies affect habitat quality and connectivity.



MOUNTAIN PINE BEETLE

We have found better detection methods, evaluated how well different control treatments work, and tested post-attack stand regeneration treatments.



HARVESTING AND HYDROLOGY

What happens to a watershed when it is harvested? We measured flow rates and timing, flood risk, erosion, and effects on fish.



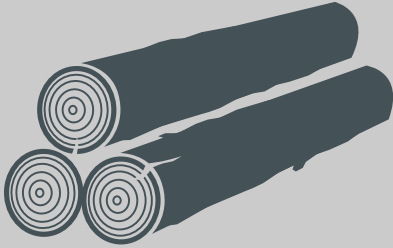
PRACTICAL ANSWERS

For threatened species, how many roads are too many? Our research has determined the road density threshold for grizzly bears in Alberta.



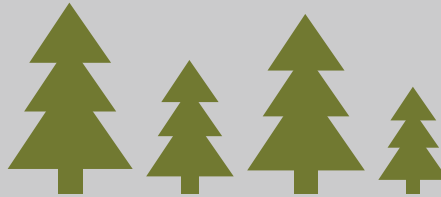
STRENGTH IN NUMBERS*
