


Lineal Inventories:

2. Berland Smoky RAD Plan boundary completed in 2013




Original line = 8m wide; Moderate regeneration with a new line cut 3m

Deficient: The disturbance has suitable vegetation growing within acceptable parameters (i.e. density, distribution, species) to meet management objectives.
Inclined: The disturbance has vegetation growing but currently not within acceptable parameters and is expected to become re-vegetated in the near future.
Deficient: The disturbance has no vegetation or vegetation growing well below the acceptable parameters. It is not clear whether these lines are, or will be, re-vegetated (specify).

- Both inventories completed by Greenlink Forestry Inc for FLMF
 - Provides managers with the ability to query various revegetation parameters that are spatially represented
- Contributing to FRI research of animal behavioral response to varying vegetation attributes
 - Provides managers with the ability to determine where and how to focus reclamation efforts
